Meghan St. Thomas has been given the assignment this summer of reading her favorite books aloud to members of her community as a way to help with reading issues brought on by possible signs of dyslexia. She chose to share this assignment with her hometown library, giving back to her community in an event she calls the Library Project. This project will entail a series of readings occurring Wednesday evenings during the summer, in which Meghan will explore excerpts from her favorite books. Meghan has grown up fascinated with stories, which in turn has led her to choose acting as her profession. This allows her to not only read about her favorite heroes and heroines, but to also become them.
